Worthy Sir Knights,

I rather imagine that year after year, the feast that the Church celebrates on October 7 slips by us with very little notice, namely, that of Our Lady of the Holy Rosary. Our Lady and her Rosary, we will recall, were an important feature of our First Degree. We received a rosary, were asked to carry it on our person and frequently pray it.
