

Thank you for applying to be a part of Rev Up & Roll 2008. This family-oriented event drew upwards of 15,000 guests at our inaugural event in 2007 and we anticipate another great day again on Sunday, June 22, 2008. Please review this application and return it with your non-refundable* fee of \$500 made payable to the Bethel Park Community Foundation. You will receive a confirmation letter from us after May 1, 2008 with further details on set up, tear down and operations at the event and a specific field assignment number prior to the event. Please take a moment to review the following items in our contract:

**Only in the event that we cannot accept your application based on duplicity of menu item, etc. will we refund your application fee.*

- Your \$500 non-refundable* fee will entitle you to a field space including a 10x10 canopy frontage plus a 10'x20' deep prep area directly behind your canopy where you may park your trailer, truck, etc. as well as set up a prep area. If you sell directly from a vehicle, please let us know that on the application.
- Menu items must be submitted in this application and approved by Rev Up & Roll. We reserve the right to limit menu items to vendors based on first come first serve of application and anticipated needs of our guests. Any change in menu items from this application must be submitted in writing and have the approval of Rev Up & Roll prior to June 15, 2008.
- You are responsible for signage at your site including your business name, menu and pricing, etc. as well as any necessary utensils, napkins, plates, cups, etc. Store menus and/or coupons at your booth are welcome.
- All beverage sales including water, soft drinks, etc. will be made available to you through the Bethel Park Community Foundation (BPCF) by pre-order and also on the day of the event. Retail sale pricing will be set by the BPCF to ensure consistent beverage pricing throughout the event. Beverage orders will be handled by separate order forms once confirmation letters are sent.
- Raffles**, games, or sale of non-contracted food or non food items at your booth are prohibited. **Non-cash raffles or drawings with promotional prizes tied back directly and solely to your booth or restaurant are permitted.
- Set Up begins at 5 AM 6/22/08. You will receive instructions to the vendor entrance at the time of your confirmation of field location. If you have a trailer, truck or other such vehicles you wish to park in your space, you may make arrangements with us to place it on the field the evening before. Rev Up & Roll and the BPCF will not assume any liability for vehicles or property parked on-site. All vehicles and/or storage trailers to be on the field must be in place no later than 7 AM 6/22/08. Tear down will begin at 8:00 PM on 6/22/08. At that time you are expected to clean your area of thoroughly and dispose of any cooking oils, garbage, etc. in proper receptacles or take it off site.
- We will have on-site storage available to you in one of the county fair buildings. In addition you may make arrangements with us to have on-site deliveries. While such vehicles will not be permitted onto the field or adjoining track area, our Go-For Team will gladly work with you to meet your truck and transport supplies to the perimeter track closest to your site.
