What to Wear... We will be giving you a PIT CREW 2008 Shirt to wear that day. You can wear shorts, jeans, capris and we highly suggest comfortable shoes. You most likely will be walking and standing... a lot. We realize that many of you may be representing another group or even doing service hours (if you need us to mark you down for credit, be sure to bring your form and give it to Kathy Zimmer) and we know you are proud of your affiliation with them, but we must have all of our volunteers in a PIT CREW shirt to make it easier for our guests to identify who’s in charge. Bring a hat, sun screen and sunglasses too!!! You’ll receive your shirt when you check in and yes there are rest room facilities in the building to change.

What Will I Be Doing...Our Volunteer Committee has spent countless long hours trying to put together a schedule with hundreds of volunteers and tons of jobs. When possible they have matched you up to a job you indicated you would like to do, and perhaps even with friends if you requested. You may know your job when they confirm your hours or you may find out when you arrive. Regardless, we will have instructions at every post explaining the job you’ll be doing.

What If I Need Help During the Day or Have Questions... Good question!
Each station will not only have an instruction sheet but will have a list of phone numbers to call for

assistance. The list will be far greater than you'll need but rest assured, help is a phone call away! Bring your cell phone in case you need to call us.

When Should I Arrive... We have you scheduled to be out on the site to volunteer for an assigned time period. It's up to you to PLEASE make sure you are in your spot when your time begins. If you are relieving someone (and unless you're doing set up, you are) think how panicked they will feel if you leave them there. Most likely they need to report somewhere else and we now have a chain reaction of volunteers not in their places going on all over the venue site. **We strongly advise you plan on arriving at the park one hour before your scheduled time.** It's going to take you some time to get to the check in and then out to your position.

So Where Do I Check In... Volunteer Check In will be at The Cottage which is located behind the large beverage trucks on the end of the site where the Museum and other buildings are. Kathy Zimmer and her crew will welcome you, get you settled and send you out to work.

Where Do I Park... We have a dedicated volunteer lot across Brownsville Road at the Concert Site/Horse Stable area. It's only going to hold so many cars and will most likely fill up early with those of us who are spending the WHOLE day (and I'm talking before the sun comes up!) Unless that's you too, you will probably want to park in any of the satellite lots in the park (such as the VIP/Skating Rink Lot, the grass hill above the children's playground or Sesqui Lot... just watch for our signs) and catch our FREE shuttle to the Corrigan Drive entrance to the park. We have two shuttles running continuously all day so you'll be able to catch a ride to and from your car. (See why we say to allow an hour?) From the Corrigan Drive entrance you are going to have to walk across the field to the Cottage, get your assignment and head on back out to the field. We will have an on-field tram available for those of you needing assistance. (Volunteers can ride for FREE... just give your name at the Corrigan Main Station when you board.) Kettle Korn or iced cream may get the best of you on the way and you may feel the need to stop and indulge.

What Do I Do When I'm Hungry... ahhhhhh, glad you asked that! When you check in, you will receive a Volunteer Voucher which you can redeem back at The Cottage for a complimentary hot dog, cool fruit and a drink. And keep in mind there are some delicious offerings to buy out there on the field. Our food vendors have out done themselves this year. We will be giving you a Rev Up and Roll mug as well. That's yours to keep and you can fill it during the day with cold water from our volunteer water stations. Kathy will let you know where they are in relation to your station when you check in.

What If I have Friends Who Want to Volunteer At the Last Minute... Just let Kathy know. Chances are good to excellent that she can use the help.
