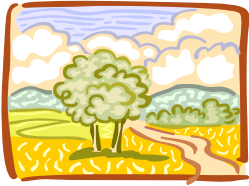
Lakewinds Sign

Landscape Committee

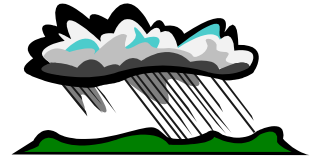
