Brenda Tharp has a keen eye for design, and her use of natural light and color are her signature.

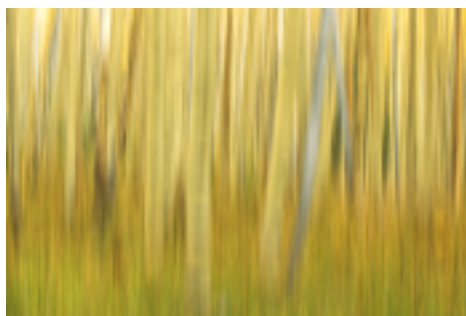
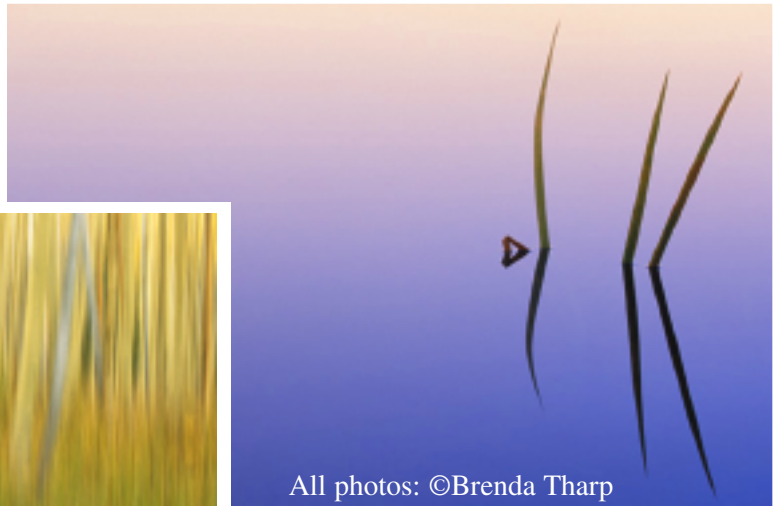
