

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MAKING YOUR OWN RECALL SIGN

Take the following pages to Kinkos and have them print each page on 11" x 17" sheets. (We used glossy paper which is more expensive, but you can use plain paper and it works just as well. The cost for printing each quadrant in color was \$1.78 per sheet. Then you trim the white edges and from the back (unprinted sides), carefully tape all four quadrants together to make a 22" x 34" sign. We went to the \$1 store and purchased cheap (fake) foam core boards and cut them to the size of the sign. Don't purchase real foam core board as it is very expensive. Note: you can also use a large piece of cardboard instead of the fake foam core if you can't find it at the \$1 store. Then, you can purchase a \$3.00 package of all-purpose sticky putty (which is enough to make several signs because you don't have to use very much per sign) and use the putty to attach the signs to the foam core boards.



To keep our signs dry, we purchased a few roles of self-adhesive (removable) clear plastic to cover each sign (we've used ours in the rain and this works great!). You can find this clear removable plastic at Staples or OfficeMax and it's a whole lot cheaper than trying to get a sign laminated (especially this large) and the removable plastic actually looks great and doesn't obscure the print. Don't try to use clear contact paper because you can't reposition it. Also, the removable plastic does not remove the ink from the sign in case you have to lift and reposition it if you don't lay it down right the first time. We've used our signs for several months and they look just as good as they did when we first made them.

We purchased a large cardboard box for about \$7 and folded it into a large triangle, taping the sides together to form an A-framed box. This works great for storing extra pens, petitions and informational handouts. Then we taped two signs loosely together at the top (like a Tee-Pee) so the signs drape over the box and you can read the sign when approaching from either the front or the back. On the left is a picture of how our signs turned out.

We had a great time making these signs and we've received a lot of compliments from members signing the petition. We even had a Joe supporter tell us they looked "professionally made"! HA!
