Waivers signed by both parents must be in house, along with a medical release form and an application before participating in camp activities.

A \$75.00 reservation fee must be paid at the time of sign up and is not refundable without a doctor's excuse or two weeks notice. Full payment due at the start of each session.

All participants must provide long cotton stretch pants for riding, tie boots or English riding boots with a 1/2" heel, if possible each participant shall provide their own USETA approved riding helmet. We have a Kids Club discount package deal that a local tack shop has offered which includes boots, riding pants and an approved helmet for a total cost of around \$98.00. We have some helmets if the child can not provide his/her own.

Each child must supply their own towel and swim wear as well as a change of clothes daily.

There will be one instructor per three campers with a maximum of six campers per week.

A list of suggested items needed is attached and should be used as a check list.

We can not predict the weather conditions or what horse the child will ride. We do ride in a misty rain but never a down pour or a thunder storm. This means that a ride or two could be missed in a week so there are no guarantees of 10 rides per week. We do our best but we have to depend on the Lord for the weather. Please prepare your child for the possibility of a fall... sometimes they do occur but very seldom.

- ✓ Sweatshirt/light jacket
- ✓ Sunglasses
- ✓ Shorts/Shirts/Jeans enough for a week
- ✓ Nightgowns (not see through), PJs or night shirts for 4 nights
- ✓ Pillow and Pillow Case (opt.)
- ✓ Baseball cap or hat (opt)
- ✓ Shoes for mucking out stalls
- ✓ Deodorant
- ✓ Soap/Shampoo/Conditioner
- ✓ Shaving needs
- ✓ Toothpaste and toothbrush
- ✓ Hairbrush/comb/barrettes or Scrunchies for tying hair back while riding
- ✓ **Medications with instructions**
- ✓ Feminine Hygiene products as needed
- ✓ Musical Instrument if desired

We are now trying to operate a green friendly camp so please do not send bottled water. We have a water filter system so they can get water from our system.

We will do laundry once during the session if necessary

There will be approximately one hour riding daily with one hour Horsemanship daily. At the end of the session girls able to pass a written test with 80% or better will get the horseman knowledge award. Girls able to pass the riding test for their level (as well as the written test) will get a Horsemanship award at the level they have been working towards.

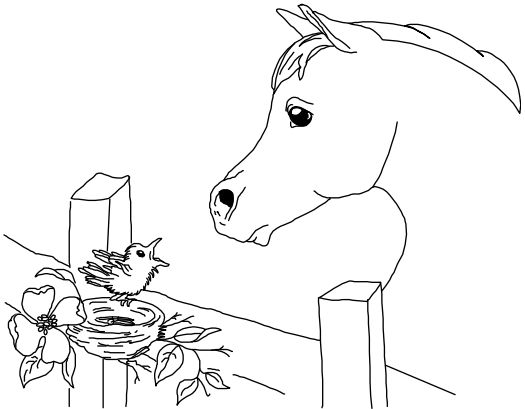
These tests are not mandatory or required.
