**HEADQUARTERS MEDICH'S BATTALION,**  
*January 1, 2005.*

I. It is the responsibility of the commander of each company affiliated with this battalion that a Return of Commissioned Officers and Non-Commissioned Officers be completed fully and submitted to the battalion adjutant. It is extremely important that this be done expeditiously so that the battalion roll book can be updated and reprinted for distribution as soon as practicable.

II. The battalion color sergeant has requested that each company provide him with a report of flags in its possession that can be used by the battalion when it is designated to portray specific units during reenactments of specific battles. This information will enable the color sergeant to avoid having to have a flag made for an event when an appropriate flag already exists in the battalion.

III. After action reports for the 2004 Campaign must be submitted to the adjutant no later than March 31 to be included in the 2004 Order Book. The events for which reports should be submitted include the School of the Battalion, the battalion spring drill, the muster at Billie creek Village, and the Battle of Franklin Campaign. Anyone with questions about what should be reported can contact either the adjutant or the battalion commander for guidance.

The cooperation of all company commanders will be greatly appreciated.
