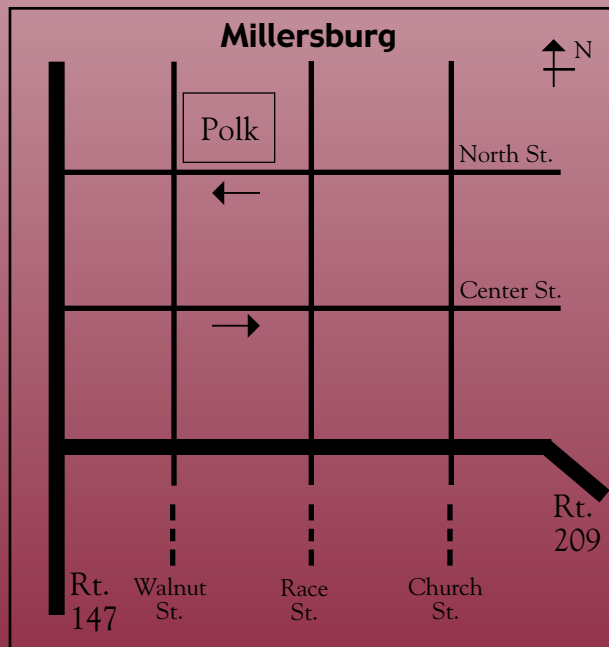


Some of the details ...

A Brief History

Men In Harmony can trace its roots back to when founding director Charles Kindt and several men began informal rehearsals after the area-wide "Oasis" evangelistic crusade of 1998.

Membership began to increase in the fall of 1999, and culminated with the group's first public performance at the St. John's Lutheran Church Strawberry Festival (Berrysburg) in June of 2000. Since then, Men In Harmony has been averaging two performances a month at various churches and nursing homes in Central Pennsylvania.

Upon Charles Kindt retiring from directing in the fall of 2005, Robert A. Stoner has taken the reigns as director. He desires to build the group into an even greater ministry in the coming years.

What We Do

Men In Harmony isn't only our name; it is also our identity. We find our hearts in harmony with the Lord and each other as brothers in His family. But our harmonizing has a more direct application – the musical one. Our songs employ two, three and four part harmonies, as well as unison.

The mission behind Men In Harmony is simple, but dual in nature. We consider our music as our voice of praise while also declaring the message of God's true love as sincere, unconditional, and unending.

Therefore, the majority of our programs sing of our Christ.

In addition to this "general" program, we also present seasonal programs for Christmas and Easter. Our love of America adds quite a selection of patriotic numbers to our repertoire.

Who We Are

Membership in Men In Harmony is open to any man who agrees to abide by the five guiding principles of the group. The first three deal with musical ability.

Each prospective member:

- (1) has and tries to maintain a reasonably pleasant sounding singing voice,
- (2) can match a given pitch while hearing other music sounds (harmonize),
- (3) can receive instruction and constructive criticism for the good of the group without personal insult.

Because we are a Christ-centered organization, the first and foremost tenet for a member of Men In Harmony:

- (4) has accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as his personal Savior and seeks to build his relationship with Him. His lifestyle will testify to his walk with the Lord.

The fifth principle is included as an acknowledgement of the unique diversity within Men In Harmony's ranks:

- (5) can rest in Christian unity, sing, and fellowship with men of varied doctrinal beliefs, while raising the banner of Jesus Christ for the sake of His kingdom's advancement.

Our goal in ministry is to encourage believers in their daily walk as Christians, and to be an attraction to non-believers, drawing them into the kingdom of God.
