

***Excerpt from 1972 CFA Yearbook, Board Minutes from the
CFA Board Meeting, Chicago, IL Sep 12, 1971***

Mr. Will Thompson reverted to the business of standards, this time for the Sphynx cat, now recognized in a provisional status. He noted that we still lacked a workable standard; Mr. Gebhardt thought we had one, provisionally speaking. Mr. Thompson said it was even poor, provisionally speaking! Dr. Peltz now expressed the opinion that this provisional standard for the Sphynx cat as sponsored by CPA had been premature, to say the least, and she would like these Minutes to reflect that since the Board was lacking a provisional standard, it should insist that the Show Rules not include any standard for the Sphynx in this show season. Whereupon Mr. Rose moved that in view of the fact that the CFA Board had been unable to accept a provisional standard for the Sphynx Breed, the Sphynx Cat not now be eligible for Provisional Breed status, despite the fact that it is listed in the Show Rules of May 1, 1971. Carried by a unanimous vote.
