

Election Board Structure

1. County Election Bureau – Laureen Hagan – phone - 610-891-4673, location - Government Center, Ground Floor 201 W. Front St., Media
2. Delaware County Election Board - Chairman Carmen P. Belefonte, William C. Kelly & Gerald Lawrence
3. Judge of Election – The supervisor of the local polling location seeks office during the Municipal elections between the presidential and governors' election.
4. Inspector of Election – One person from each party will be elected as an inspector, the one with the most votes will be the majority inspector and the other will be the minority inspector.

Both parties may have as many candidates as those who wish to seek the offices as long as they file valid petitions. There is a simultaneous primary for each party in the spring with the winners running against their opposition in the fall General Election. These positions are for four years and they start the January after they are elected. If the position is filled after the election by a court appointment the term expires the January of the year of the governors' election. The positions may also be filled by a curbside election which is done at the polling location on the day of the election.

5. Clerk – Appointed by the Minority Inspector – assists in the functions of the inspectors.
6. Machine Operator – Appointed by the Election Bureau to operate the voting machine.

The term of office is January 2010 to January 2014 for those elected in 2009 or appointed after 2009 General Election. Curbside elections are valid for that election only.
