Code of Conduct

The following is an agreement by the student and parent/guardian. All students enrolled in Modular Technology at L'Anse Creuse High School must return this form signed by both parties prior to work dealing directly with the technology lab equipment.

1. There is no food, gum, or drinks allowed in the lab.
2. No floppy disks, compact disks (music or other), mini-disks, CD players or other forms of data storage may be brought into the lab without the instructor's consent.
3. No student is allowed to use technology lab equipment, including the application room, without the Technology Code of Conduct signed by both the student and parent/guardian.
4. Any action that compromises the safety of ANYONE in the lab will be dealt with severely. The use of any equipment or tool without proper instruction and permission of the instructor is prohibited.
5. Students are **financially** responsible for items that are damaged or lost through misuse or carelessness. This responsibility includes the "Five-minute rule" as outlined in the Modular Technology course information.
6. Students will abide by the class procedures and any additional instructions given by the instructor.
7. Tampering with the security of the computer system and/or using the computers or any other equipment for purposes other than which they were intended can result in the loss of all computer privileges. This includes changing or vandalizing programs/software, or hardware. Other disciplinary action as deemed appropriate by the instructor may be taken.
