

## Sailing Instructions Change #1 for Mug Race 2007

### Insert new Sailing Instruction 1.6 and 1.7 under Rules:

- 1.6 All participants will be provided with an adhesive number (Mug Race Number) to be displayed on the mainsail. This number should be on the upper third of the sail near the leech on the starboard side. If the number will not adhere ensure that it is displayed to the finish boat at finish and any official Mug Race Patrol Boat that approaches.
- 1.7 Participants will also be provided with a lime green pennant to be displayed from the backstay or starboard shroud if no backstay exists. Other boats must secure these pennants at a height where it is readily visible. The pennant should continue to be displayed until the boat is well clear of the race course.

### Substitute the following for rule 7.5 North Course:

**7.5 North Course-** Start at the line approximately  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile south of the Buckman Bridge (N30 11.1 W81 39.7) on the east side of the river. Proceed west approximately 1 mile to marker "A" (N30 11.1 W81 41.0) leaving it to port. Proceed south approximately 5 miles to mark "B" (N30 05.4 W81 40.1) leaving it to port. Proceed back north to marker "A" leaving it to port. Proceed south to marker "C" (N29 59.5 W81 38.6) located approximately  $\frac{1}{2}$  Mile north of The Shands Bridge leaving it to port. Proceed back north to marker "A" leaving it to starboard and proceed to finish line. Attachment A to this change is a diagram of the updated course.

**Note:** All positions approximate. Rhumb lines between marks do not necessarily provide for safe navigation. Each entrant is responsible for its own safe navigation.
