- 📖 Use your Bible and *Journey through the New Testament* to answer the numbered questions below.
- 📖 Your answers are to be typed, double-spaced, spell-checked, and proofread.
- 📖 Number your answers to correspond with the questions.
- 📖 Your answers are to be in complete sentences. Use appropriate grammar.
- 📖 Do not use or copy anything from the Internet. There are no exceptions to this commandment.
- 📖 You may quote directly from *Journey through the New Testament*. If you quote, you must use quotation marks and identify the page number from which the quoted material has come, e.g., “With the stoning of Stephen, the Jerusalem community scattered” (187).
- 📖 Staple together the pages of your project. When you come to class on Tuesday, May 26, the pages of your project must already be stapled. Do not come to class requesting a stapler.
- 📖 There is no need for pictures in this project; do not include any pictures.
- 📖 There is no need for a cover page; do not include one.
- 📖 Use the following model for the heading information on your first page. (Note: change the name from *Hannibal Smith* to your own name.) For the heading information, you need not double space. If you do not know how to double space only some of the text, you may double space even the heading information.
- 📖 I strongly recommend that you complete and print out your project by Friday, May 22, so that a parent or another competent reader can aid you in proofreading. After someone has read your project, make any needed corrections and print a final edition.
- 📖 See Mr. Dolan about any questions you have with how to do this project.

4. Which of the catholic epistles “gives witness to the earliest celebration of the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick” (*Journey through the New Testament*, p. 227)

Read pp. 228-299 to answer the following questions.

5. One of the Catholic Epistles was probably used as a source for one of the other Catholic Epistles.
    - 5a. Which letter was used as a source?
    - 5b. By which other letter was that letter used as a source?
    - 5c. Why do scholars suspect that the one letter was used as a source by the other?
  6. Of the three Johannine epistles, only one is addressed to a particular individual?
    - 6a. Which of the Johannine epistles is addressed to a particular individual?
    - 6b. What is the name of that individual?
    - 6c. Use your Bible to identify the chapter and verse where that individual is named.
