

Knitting Basket

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Cast 3 stitches.

Row 1: kfb (knit in the front and the back) of each stitch (6 stitches total)

Row 2 and all even rows: purl

Row 3: repeat row 1 (12 stitches)

Row 5: *k1, kfb, repeat from *

Row 7: *k2, kfb, repeat from *

Row 9: *k3, kfb, repeat from *

Continue this way, with one more stitch between increases each odd row until you have 20 stitches between increases, ending with an even row.

From this point on you will work in the round.

Next row (RS): join you work without twisting it, put a stitch marker to

mark the beginning of the round, purl to end

Next row: purl to end.

Work in stockinette until your work is 13 inches high.

Count your stitches and bind off 1/4 of your stitches, knit another 1/4 of your stitches, bind off 1/4 of your stitches, knit to end.

Cast on the same number of stitches you bind off, knit to the next point you casted off, cast on the stitches you bind off, knit to end.

Continue in stockinette for 1 inch.

Bind off.

Sew the bottom. Felt. Dry

Put your knitting project in it and go to your LYS knit night.

Materials:

worsted weight wool 500 yds

circular needles US# 10

tapestry needle

stitch marker

Measurements:

height 8.5 inches

diameter 11 inches
