

Cashmerino Hats

I made these hats to go with a couple of baby cardigans I made with Debbie Bliss Cashmerino Aran #300101, #300208 and #300202. You'll need a ball in each color.

Sizes: infant (1-2 years).

Gauge: 18 sts/4" on US #8

Needles: 16" US #8 circular and dpns.



Tie Knot Hat:

Cast 60 (72) stitches with MC on circular and do 4 rows of Garter Stripe Pattern. Change to MC and knit until work measures 4" (4.5").

Switch to dpns and begin decreases:

R1: K2 tog, knit 8

R2: K2 tog, knit 7

R3: K2 tog, knit 6

and so on until you have 9 stitches on the needles. Work around these for 3.5". Bind off. Tie the long seam into a knot.

Rolled Brim Hat:

Cast 60 (72) stitches and work in Stockinette Stripe Pattern until work is 4.5" (5"). Switch to dpns and begin decreases:

R1: K2 tog, knit 8

R2: K2 tog, knit 7

R3: K2 tog, knit 6

and so on until K2 tog all around. Cut yarn and pull it through stitches. Make a pom-pom and attach it on top.

Patterns:



Garter Stripe Pattern:

Round 1: knit with MC

Round 2: purl with MC.

Round 4: knit with CC.

Round 4: purl with CC.

Stockinette Stripe Pattern:

Round 1: knit with MC.

Round 2: knit with MC.

Round 3: knit with CC.

Round 4: knit with CC.
