## Judge Rules Freedom Hill Must Share Fees



STERLING HEIGHTS, Mich. (AP) - A federal judge says Freedom Hill Amphitheater operators must share parking and ticket sales revenue with Macomb County.

The judge says Hillside Productions must honor provisions agreed upon in a contract with the county and Sterling Heights.

Hillside operates the concert venue inside Freedom Hill County Park. As a result of the ruling earlier this month, the company has to furnish receipts to figure out how much it owes the county in back revenue since 2001.

Operators canceled the entire concert season in 2006 due to a dispute over parking fees.
