

# Rivergrove needs You....

## VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES NOVEMBER 2011

### 1. CITY COUNCILOR:

The Rivergrove City Council is an elected body of 5 councilors who hold a public City Council meeting on the evening of the second Monday of each month. There is currently an opening on the Council as a result of the resignation of one councilor, and that seat may be filled by an appointment of the mayor, with approval of Council. This term expires in January 2012, and the appointed individual may choose to run for a new term at the November 2011 general election. This is a "working" council and it is hoped that the new appointee will be willing to volunteer some additional time to work on a specific project.

### 2. EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS COMMITTEE:

An excellent way to meet your neighbors! An Emergency Preparedness Plan sets up a network to alert citizens and offer needed resources when an emergency strikes, like the severe floods of the late 1990s. While some block captains are still willing to volunteer as the City updates its Emergency Preparedness Plan, others are needed in various parts of the city, and especially in subdivisions built in the last 10 years.

### 3. REVISION OF RIVERGROVE LAND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE:

This is a two-year project, scheduled from December 2011 to December 2013. It will result in the revision of all our land use ordinances and the possible creation of new ones as needed. Prior land use experience is helpful but not essential. A willingness to work hard to evaluate and determine direction for the project is necessary. There will also be a need for volunteers to do less technical work, such as distribution and clerical duties.

### 4. RECORD RIVERGROVE'S HISTORY:

Trace and record the city's roots. Conduct interviews with those who knew Rivergrove at its incorporation 40 years ago. Assemble a photographic history of the city
