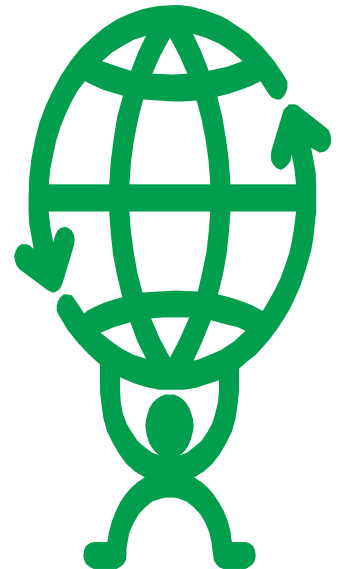


## Concerts and events
