Arcangelo Corelli, "Sonata a Quattro" (AATB); if anyone plays only soprano, let Tish know (via Ron Emery) and she will write a part. And John Dowland, "To ask for all thy love" (SAupTB). Contrabass or viol would be welcome.

Ms. Berlin teaches privately and at workshops, including Amherst Early Music Festival, and she directs the Hidden Valley Early Music Elderhostel in Carmel Valley. She performs with the Farallon Recorder Quartet, recorder duo Tibia, and Wild Rose and has appeared with the San Francisco Symphony, the Carmel Bach Festival, and Atlanta Baroque Orchestra. Ms. Berlin holds a master's degree from Case Western Reserve University and a Bachelor of Music in piano performance from U. of North Carolina. Currently she serves on the board of the American Recorder Society.

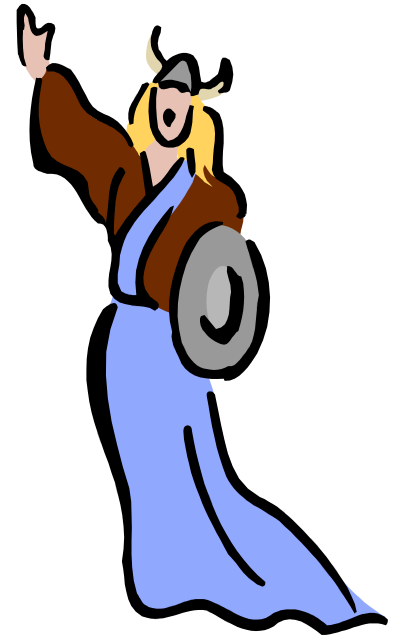
Next Board Meeting
