## Tour of New MacPhail School of Music

Tour the new MacPhail School of Music, due to open in January, 2008, designed by James Dayton Designs, Inc.

Located in the Mill District, amid renovated mill buildings and newer neo-mill architecture, the new MacPhail will stand out as it will employ an innovative combination of corten steel, tin-coated copper, glass curtain-wall and fiber-cement panels.

The new 58,000 sq. ft. building will house a performance hall, instruction studios and early childhood development classrooms, all of which will have superior acoustics. In addition to the formal learning spaces, the new MacPhail will contain a large lobby that doubles as a secondary performance space, school offices, a cafe and an outdoor performance courtyard.
