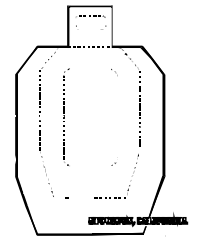

## Match Highlights

"VPS only had six shooters this last weekend. We will die as a club.... its a matter of when. With that good news out of the way lets go to the stages.

Stage 1: Three boxes with a total of 21 shots. This was a simple, but challenging stage. Bryan Nakabayashi won this stage.

Stage 2: This stage had 31 shots and a new activating target. It is a plate that when hit flips up a target. It worked like a champ thanks to a fine welding job by Ron Nakabayashi (looks like hell, but it held). Gary Orr built the device in his garage using a car seat spring thingy that allows the car seat to fold forward. He let me weld on it. The rest of the targets were behind walls and it was a shoot'em as ya see'em stage. I finished first (probably cause of the fine welding job).

Stage 3: This was a classifier that is called "Front Sight". Bryan Nakabayashi did this in 5.16 seconds and won it.

Stage 4: This was the same as stage 2 except the activating plate was removed. Bryan Nakabayashi won this stage with a 12.16 second run. The nearest shooter was over 4 seconds behind!

After the match there was some fine tri-tip, potato salad, bread, and drinks thanks to Marie Olivas.

Mark Olivas was in military training and thus didn't shoot. Comments were made about how quiet the range was without Mark there, but Rob said he missed Mark's mouth. Rob can explain that in next month's newsletter.

### Qualification for Nationals Slot

You must shoot 10 of the matches in the division you're going to try to win the slot in, i.e. open or limited. You can get additional chances to win the slot by being a match director or board member.
