John Daly Weds Virginia Warren In a Methodist Church on Coast

SAN FRANCISCO, Dec. 22—Miss Virginia Warren, daughter of Chief Justice and Mrs. Earl Warren, was married today to John Charles Daly, the television personality.

The ceremony took place in the chapel of Glide Memorial Methodist Church, with the Rev. Dr. Ernest Stilwell Heeren, pastor of the First Congregational Church, officiating.

The Chief Justice of the United States, a former Governor of California, gave the bride in marriage in the presence of 200 guests. Miss Warren was

attended by her sisters, Mrs. Stewart Brian and Mrs. Carmine D. Clements, as bridesmaids.

Mr. Daly's best man was his uncle, Herbert Cockshaw. The ushers were the bride's brothers, James C. Warren, Earl Warren Jr. and Robert Warren.

This was the second marriage for Mr. Daly, whose marriage to Margaret Griswell Neal in 1937 ended in divorce last April. He resigned recently as an executive of the American Broadcasting Company. He conducts the television show "What's My Line?"
