### *Sea Scouting*

Sea Scout Ship 508 is an organization for young men of high school age (you must have completed eighth grade to be eligible for membership). Our program is based on a nautical theme and includes canoeing, sailing, camping, community projects, social events, and vocational activities. We also conduct training in seamanship skills. This program is the high school program of the boy scouts of America and our ship has been active for over 60 years!

We meet from 7:30pm till 9:00pm every Wednesday at our Sea Scout building on the Rock River near Sinnissippi Park (the first parking lot south of the auburn street cloverleaf).

Cost is \$10.00 for annual registration, \$2.50 annual insurance. We wear navy type uniforms these are rented for \$2.00 per year with a \$5.00 cleaning deposit. These uniforms are worn at least once a month and on special ceremonies.

Ship 508 participates in 8 to 10 weekend events a year, most of these have competition with other units in the nautical skills; attendance at these is optional and you pay for those you attend. We have several work events where the members can earn money to be held in a special account for them to use for these events; some of our members have paid for all the events in a year with money left over.
