...Dear brothers and sisters, dear friends in the United States, I am very much looking forward to being with you. I want you to know that, even if my itinerary is short, with just a few engagements, my heart is close to all of you, especially to the sick, the weak, and the lonely. I thank you once again for your prayerful support of my mission. I reach out to every one of you with affection, and I invoke upon you the maternal protection of the Blessed Virgin Mary...



— In addition to praying at ground zero in New York for the victims of the Sept. 11, 2001, terrorist attacks and for their families, Pope Benedict XVI will pray for peace and understanding in the world. (...); Describing the site as "the scene of incredible violence and pain," the prayer asks God to grant eternal light and peace to all who died there when terrorists flew two planes into the World Trade Center. It also recalls those who died the same day at the Pentagon and in Shanksville, Pa. According to the missal, the pope will pray: "God of peace, bring your peace to our violent world: peace in the hearts of all men and women and peace among the nations of the earth." The pope will say, "God of understanding, overwhelmed by the magnitude of this tragedy, we seek your light and guidance as we confront such terrible events... Grant that those whose lives were spared may live so that the lives lost here may not have been lost in vain," the prayer says. "Comfort and console us, strengthen us in hope, and give us the wisdom and courage to work tirelessly for a world where true peace and love reign among nations and in the hearts of all," it concludes. The missal says the pope will begin the visit by kneeling in silence. He will then light a candle and recite the special prayer written for the occasion.

Dzisiejsza Liturgia słowa „zbiera” orędzie ewangeliczne z minionego tygodnia. Często zastanawiamy się nad sensem słuchania tych samych słów, skoro Biblia jest tak obszerna. A przecież wiemy, że powtarza się tylko to, co jest ważne lub nie cierpiące zwłoki. Orędzie nadziei związane ze Zmartwychwstałym, który prowadzi, oświeca i napełnia życiem, nigdy się nie zdezaktualizuje. I choć mrok śmierci zasłania naszą teraźniejszość i jutro, Chrystus ten mrok już przekroczył.
