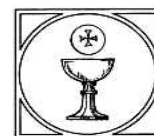
**RAFFLE TICKETS** will be sold by the members of the Women's Guild after all Masses today.

## A NEW TAX INCENTIVE TO GIVE.

Have you been waiting for the federal government to make it easier to give? If so, this may be our opportunity. New tax legislation permits people over 70 1/2 to donate from their IRA or Roth IRA to non-profit institutions such as St. Joseph Parish and the Archbishop's Annual Appeal without paying the deferred income tax. Instead of taking the required withdrawal from your IRA, you can donate the required amount to your parish. You can give up to \$100,000 total to as many organizations as you like in 2007. The opportunity ends Dec. 31, 2007. Speak to Fr. Marek Sobczak and he will put you in touch with the Diocesan Office of Development for further information. This is a wonderful opportunity to make a memorial gift to St. Joseph Parish.
