

## Free HIV Test

The Wellness Program of the UMC in Senegal entered in its third phase on July 18, 2006: that of dealing with HIV/AIDS issue. Senegal is one of the countries where AIDS has made very few damage on populations: 1.5% according to the government; 2.9% according to other international organizations related to this disease in Senegal. The Senegalese government has taken this issue seriously since the beginning of the pandemic and lot of efforts have been made to fight against it.

Thanks to a grant of 5000\$ received from GBGM this year, the Wellness program undertook a huge AIDS free test campaign in the village of Nianing on Monday, July 18, 2006 with the help of the National Program of HIV/AIDS. 400 people were tested that day; one of them was found very sick and two other people are just leaving with the virus. Other activities of this type will be scheduled later nationwide to help the Senegalese government in its effort to seek for the wellbeing of men, women and children.
