## **CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP**

Club Championship will be moving back to the old format of 2 consecutive Thursdays in August. Please see 2009 Calendar on the website for dates. Each league will have their own championship with the exception that a 9 hole member (day or evening) may choose to play in the 18 hole day league championship if they would like to.

## **RAIN CHECK POLICY FOR EVENING LEAGUE**

The Pro Shop will be notifying Terry Klatt whenever an official rainout is called by the course. Credit will be given to the evening league as follows: First half: credit will be applied toward 2<sup>nd</sup> half greens fees. Terry will post notice in locker room when 2<sup>nd</sup> half fees are due. Second half: credit will be given back to each player at the end of the year by BHLL. No rain checks will be issued to any player from the pro shop. Each player is required to deposit the first half greens fees with membership as usual and 2<sup>nd</sup> half full greens fees in mid June. For those paying full season up front, credit will be issued at the end of the season from BHLL for any official rainouts. THIS DOES NOT MEAN YOU WILL BE CALLED WHEN A RAINOUT OCCURS. IT IS STILL YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO SHOW AT THE COURSE TO DETERMINE IF A RAINOUT IS IN EFFECT.

## **FALL TOURNEY, END OF YEAR CELEBRATION**

This year we will not have an evening fall banquet. The day leagues will have a shotgun start in the morning with luncheon and awards afterwards.

Evening League will have a shotgun start at 5:30 followed by an awards ceremony and casual food.

### **SEASON LONG NET COMPETITION and MATCH PLAY**

We will be going back to Match Play for the 18 hole day league. Details will be posted in the locker room. Please indicate if you would like to play by circling the YES on your registration form. There will be a \$5 fee for Match Play this year. Please add to your membership check.

For the evening and day 9 hole leagues, we will once again do the Season Long Net competition. Please add \$5 to your registration if you choose to do this. This is a NET competition. Players are required to compete in a minimum of 8 qualifying events. A qualifying event is any of the Social Play days noted on a calendar. If more than 8 qualifying events are played, the lowest 8 net scores will be used for this competition. This is a “medal” play competition, and therefore all holes must be completed by holing out regardless of the format being played on any particular Thursday event. Players with the lowest total net score for 8 events will qualify for the prize money. Number of places paid will be contingent on the number of participants. Everyone is eligible and it only requires you to record your weekly gross score and handicap on the sheet that will be provided.

### **18 HOLE INVITATIONAL TOURNAMENT: July 9th, 8:00 AM shotgun**

Mark your calendars to sign up for a fun day of golf. We invite many of the other leagues around the metro to come and play at Bunker Hills. Prizes, lunch, Greens fees and carts are included for one low price! Invite a friend or come alone ... take the day off ... it's a great day of golf! Our goal is to have 144 players (116 last 2 years running so it's feasible!)
