

WELCOME TO BUNKER HILLS LADIES LEAGUE (BHLL)

Our League kicks off every year with a Rules Seminar/Spring Social. See separate flyer for more information. Your dues are utilized to pay for handicap fees and administrative costs (mailings, registrations, banquets, event prizes, etc.) We have 2 leagues (9 hole & 18 hole) that play on Thursday mornings and a 9 hole Evening League on Thursday evenings.

PATRON CARDS – Available through the Pro Shop

All members of Bunker Hills Ladies League are eligible to purchase a Patron Card. Further questions on patron cards should be directed to the pro shop at 763-755-4141.

Day League (9 and 18 hole) Tee Times – both played on regulation course. Tee times are from 7AM-8:30AM. Sign up for tee times is done every Thursday morning, for play on the following Thursday. You may sign up to play with anyone you wish, on the league you signed up for. **DO NOT PUT YOUR NAME ON MORE THAN ONE TEE TIME.** If you are not at Bunker and wish to sign up for the following Thursday, have a friend sign you up, or call the pro shop on **Friday** and they'll plug your name in. Please sign up in 4-somes only. Make sure you only sign up for a tee time for the group in which you are playing so all members have a chance to play at a time they prefer.

NOTE: Due to the low participation by the 9 Hole Day league, the public will be intermingled between the early and later tee times.

9 Hole Regulation Evening League – Played on the regulation course. Tee times are assigned and are the same each week, except when special event Shotguns are held. Be sure to ask the pro shop which course you are on for that day. Tee times start at 4:00 and end at 6:00. Only foursomes are allowed in the evening league. If you play on the evening league, please try to be on time or contact one of your teammates to advise if you are not coming, sending a sub or running late.

All leagues have **scheduled events** throughout the year. Some of these include a club shotgun starts, Invitational / Guest Day where other clubs and/or your friends are invited to play and enjoy lunch and prizes, a Fall Tournament, and others. In some cases you can make your own foursome, in others you will be placed in a foursome. These events are run by volunteers on the league. It is everyone's responsibility to assist in making our events a success. Consider volunteering to run an event. It's a great way to meet other members of your league and takes a minimal amount of time.

Most of the days that do not have special events are "**social play**" days. Prizes are awarded on these days according to the list of events posted in the locker room. (Least putts, Low Poker Hand, Throw Out Tourney, Low Gross / Net etc. depending on the league). Refer to your league Social Play Calendar for the day's event. Score cards must be double checked, signed by two players, dated and deposited in the appropriate league box to be eligible for events. Please be sure you understand the rules of the social "game" for the day prior to teeing off to avoid being disqualified for prizes that week.

Weekly winners and prizes will be posted on the board in the ladies locker room by the following week of play. Be sure to check and see if you may have won something. Your "account" balance is kept at the Pro Shop Desk. Any questions, please contact your Social Play chair for your league or the league Secretary.

All prices have an expiration date of October 1st each year, and must be used prior to expiration. Unclaimed prizes at year end are returned to the League Budget.

If there is a **luncheon** in conjunction with an event, you must sign up and pay by the deadline. There are always sign up boards posted in the locker room weeks in advance. Indicate your choice of meals (if there are more than one) and place a check in the envelope. Cancellations are only accepted before a head count is turned in, otherwise there are no refunds. Contact the Committee Chair if you have any event questions.

Invitational Golf Tournaments - Every year our ladies league members are invited to play at other courses throughout Minnesota, with their ladies league members. It's a really fun way to check out other courses and make new friends. Simply sign up by the deadline, pay the entry fee by check, and show up on time. You must have an 18 hole handicap to play the 18 hole invitationals. Any questions regarding invitationals should be directed to the Vice President.

MWPGA Tournaments - As a member of the ladies league you will be given a handicap which then allows you to participate in statewide tournaments sponsored by the Minnesota Women's Public Golf Association. The information and sign-ups for the tournaments are posted in the locker room. Questions may be directed to our club representative or log on to www.mwpga.org for more details.

MWGA Tournaments - Bunker Hills has joined the Minnesota Women's Golf Association. There is an additional membership fee, see website for costs. Joining the MWGA gives you the opportunity to play in tournaments at some of the areas best private and semi-private courses. SCORE CARDS --- what to do?

Everyone is required to turn in their score cards and post their weekly scores! The following must be done to be eligible for the event or social play prizes for the day:

- **Double check** each players scores on the card
- **Adjust** each players score according to the players handicap (IF YOU DO NOT KNOW HOW, ask a fellow golfer, or someone in the pro shop. They will be happy to assist you.)
- The card should be **dated and signed by two players** who have checked scores
- Each player should **Post** their adjusted score in the computer the day of the event.
- Place your **card in the appropriate box** in the ladies locker room

NOTE: In order to be eligible for social play events, you must record your scores on Social Play sheets each week. You should note your current handicap on all sheets. Make sure you post your scores in a timely manner. Scores are submitted on the 1st and 15th of each month for handicap calculations. Handicaps are needed to participate in Social Play, Match Play, Tournaments and 18 Hole Skins. Each member will be responsible for entering her own scores. You can also enter your scores via the internet at www.ghin.com

Not posting all of your scores may make you ineligible for social play and for club championship!
