Pack your swimsuit & towel on top. You will need them for swim checks as soon as we get to camp.

Things that are not listed, like cooking and cleanup supplies, are furnished by the Troop.

The Troop has some equipment to lend.

Check the Troop Handbook or website (see below) for equipment recommendations.

Items marked with an A are required, B's are recommended, & C's are optional.

Adjust quantities for the number of people. Wherever a quantity is not listed it is one (1). Some items can be shared such as stoves and tents, etc.

You must write your name on everything. Metal stuff must be etched because ink wears off.
