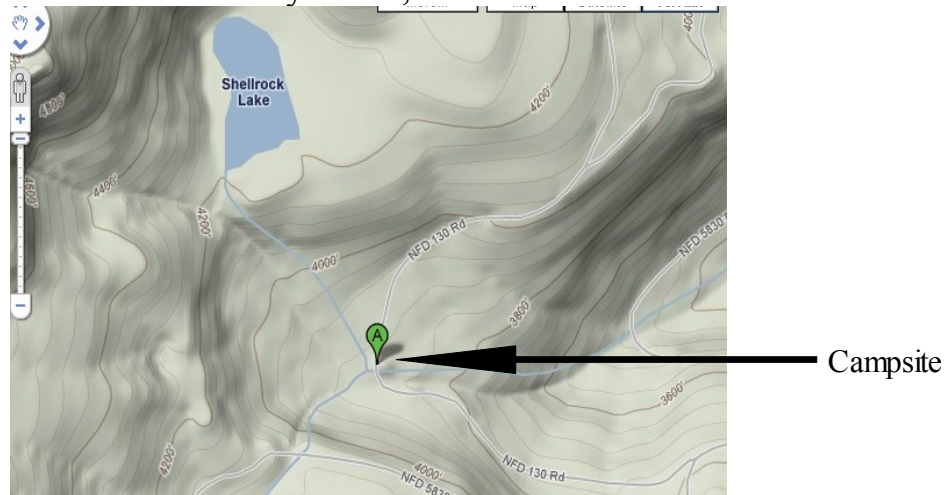


# Campout Shellrock Lake

July 24-25, 2009



This month's campout will be near Shellrock lake in the mountains above the Clackamas river. The campsite will be a primitive roadside camp, a creek will be nearby, but water is not potable. No restrooms or other facilities will be available. This location is fairly remote but still sees moderate use during the summer.

We will leave the chapel at **4:30 PM** Friday afternoon, we should have the boys back home around **12:00** Saturday afternoon.

The **Troop** will provide a hotdog dinner Friday night, the boys should bring their own breakfast and lunch Saturday.

Scouts should bring the items on the [CAMPOUT GEAR CHECKLIST](#) the weather may be cool at night, a warm sleeping bag and a couple sweaters would be a good idea. Please don't bring cell phones, Ipods, MP3 players, DVD players, PSPs, Nintendo DS, laptops, ghetto blasters, electric razors, electric lawnmowers or other electronic devices. Cameras are the only electronic gadgets allowed on campouts, the camping experience will be most enjoyable without other devices.

Shellrock lake is stocked regularly with Brook and Cutthroat trout and is accessible by a short hike from the campsite following shellrock creek cross country to the lake. Boys 14 and older who wish to fish in the lake will need to have a fishing license (a juvenile license costs \$6.75 and may be purchased at any sporting goods store or at the sporting goods counter at Bi-Mart or Wal-Mart.)
