RUSSIA REVISITED

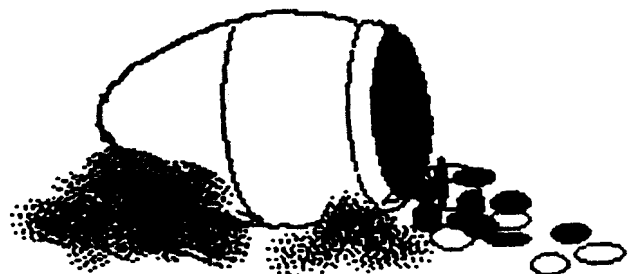

If you have coins or other items relating to medieval or contemporary Russia or Poland, please bring them to the meeting to share in the discussion.

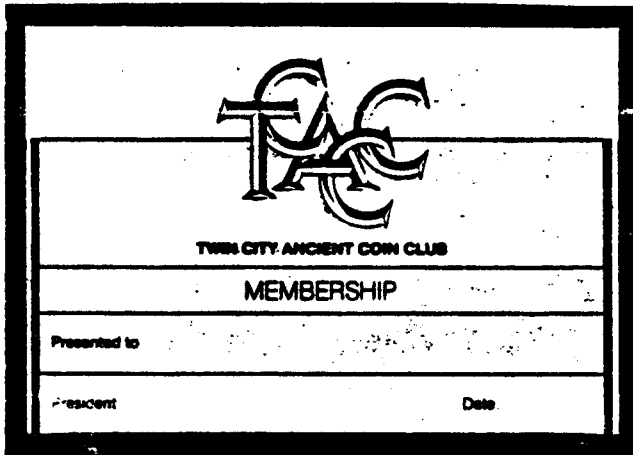
