Mr. Art Noot will discuss the coinage of the Roman Republic and Empire, utilizing slides demonstrating Rome's two great contributions to the coinage of antiquity: the principle of varying types and the development of portraiture. While the birth of coinage at Rome came late in comparison with that of the Mediterranean basin as a whole, both the Republican and Imperial issues acquired and developed an actuality and realism which is almost totally lacking in any other period.
