You have a choice of two sign designs. One is a basic nameplate that shows the building name and year of construction. Another style includes space for text about the history of the building, house or site. The signs are \$68.50 and \$98.50.

Signs within each community ( Millville, Glenwood, Lynn Haven, Cove area etc.) will be personalized with logos representing that community.

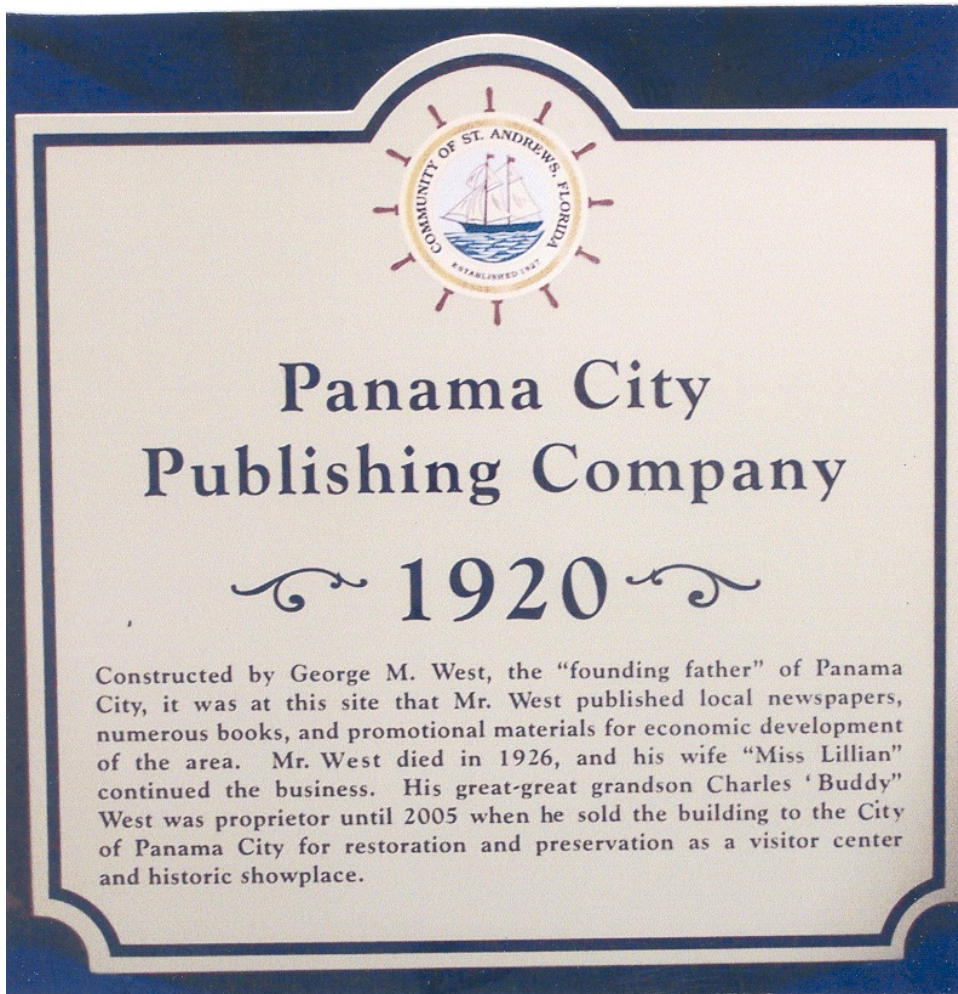

## **Placement of Historical Signs in the Panama City Area**

### **Commercial Buildings:**

- A. The historical sign is to be placed at 64 inches measured at the center of the sign to the front sidewalk or front entrance level.
- B. The historical sign is to be on the building face, and when possible, on the street address side. Exact location will depend on the architectural design of the building and the owner's preferences.

### **Private homes:**

- A. Placement is to be in a location which allows the name of the home and the date to be read from the street.
- B. Placement is to be on the street address side of the home.
- C. Because of the different settings for each home the location is to be determined by the owner but keeping in mind that it is readable from the street and ideally is on the street address side of the home.

### **Other Locations:**

Sign placement on other locations will depend on factors at each site.
