



Reading Homework

Your child will be bringing home two books every week for reading homework. Each book will be stored in a Ziploc bag and placed inside of your child's T.I.G.E.R book. Your child will be responsible for taking care of the books and returning them to school.

The first book will typically be sent home on Monday. Your child may keep the book at home each night (please store it in the Ziploc bag) but it must be returned to school on Wednesday. The second book will be sent home on Wednesday. Your child may keep the book at home each night (please store it in the Ziploc bag) but it must be returned to school on Friday. Please put the book in the Ziploc bag and place it inside of your child's T.I.G.E.R book. Please read the book each night that your child has it at home and initial the box on the chart for the appropriate day.

There are three types of books your child may bring home:

- Site word or predictable readers from our reading curriculum
- Fluency readers from our Phonics curriculum
- Decodable readers from our Phonics curriculum (these may be colored)

Below are some suggestions to help your child become a successful reader:

- Read the book to your child.
- Have your child echo read the book (you read, your child echoes you).
- Your child reads to you, a sibling, another family member, or a friend.
- Count the number of words in a sentence.
- Count the number of letters in a word.
- Count the number of letters in a sentence.
- Count all the words in the story.
- Count all the letters in the story.
- Find the longest/shortest word.
- Find the longest/shortest sentence.
- Find certain letters or sounds.
- Find or recite rhyming words.
- Point to the title, author, and illustrator.
- Find the title page.
- Find certain page numbers.
- Find a certain word on a page.
- Answer questions about the story: who, what, when, where, why, and how.
