



Kindergarten Homework

Kindergarten students will receive a weekly homework assignment sheet describing their homework. This assignment sheet and the accompanying paperwork will be in the front pocket of your child's T.I.G.E.R. book at the beginning of the week. Each day (Monday–Thursday) your kindergartener will have two or three short activities to complete. Your child may have reading, writing, drawing, coloring, cutting, pasting, or an oral assignment. Materials your child should have at home to complete homework:

- crayons for drawing, coloring, or writing.
- pencils for drawing and writing.
- a glue stick for pasting.
- a pair of scissors for cutting.



All written and/or drawing assignments have a page attached to the weekly homework assignment sheet where your child is to complete the work. Please help your child complete his homework each night and return the homework sheets in the front pocket of your child's T.I.G.E.R. book on Friday.
