**\*Note:** This Sumbling family is listed as black, but I believe this is white family of Quitman and **Lottie Ann Powell** Summerlin and oldest daughter Mary Ann, b 1883. The infant female A D is undocumented. The woman's initials look like "T A", and the letter "T" on this census is usually very distinct from an "L". However, on household #357 the "L" in "Levins" and on #237 the "L" in "Linton" look exactly like the "T" in the initials "T A Sumbling" above, leading me to believe it is really "L A Sumbling". The IQ Summerlin and JS Stafford families were also adjacent on the 1900 census, Hurricane Creek Precinct. **Elizabeth Owens** Stafford and **Lottie Ann Powell** Summerlin were first cousins.
