Learn to Play DISC GOLF

The "Friends of Wilson Disc Golf" are providing instruction on how to play disc golf at the Wilson Park 4-Hole disc golf course. This is **intended primarily for elementary and middle school children** in the TE school district. Family members are welcome to join their kids.

Disc Golf is played just like ball golf, but with a disc (e.g. a Frisbee™), using special targets (baskets) for the "holes". Disc Golf can be played with any "flying disc". There are special golf discs that are smaller and heavier than normal discs - designed to be sturdier with better flight (and not for catching), but they are not required to play or have fun.

In the class, we'll cover the **basic disc golf throws**, including drives, approaches, and putts, and have plenty of time for **course practice**.

There is no cost for the instruction, but you **must pre-register**.

Participants must bring a disc for their own use. Real golf discs are available (with the custom Tredyffrin Township logo shown above) for \$10 each. Proceeds help pay for the course signs, tees, and supplies.
