Dave Gantt - Head Volleyball Coach
 David Gantt, former head women's volleyball coach at both Montana State University and Oregon State University, was named head coach at Gonzaga University in late January of 2009. Having previous head coaching experience at Oregon State University and Northern Montana College, Gantt has accumulated a 216-160 (57.4 percent) career record during his 14-year head coaching career. Gantt previously served as head coach at Oregon State from 1991-93. During his two-year stint with the Beavers, Gantt led OSU to a 29-36 mark in the Pacific 10 Conference, which is considered one of the best volleyball leagues in the country.

Camp directors **Momi Bowles** and **Kelley Spink** return for their 21st year of Gonzaga Camp. Both are former GU stand-outs. Momi is the Head Volleyball Coach at Auburn Mountainview High School, located in Auburn, Washington, while Kelley is a past member of the USA National Team and a former GU assistant coach.

Gonzaga University assistant volleyball coach **Abby Bennett** will be a key member of the coaching and administrative staff for 2009. Abby has returned to her alma mater and enters her second season as an assistant coach. Cullen, a four-year starter for the Bulldogs from 2000-03, ranks in the top 10 in the Zags career record book for block assists, block solos, total blocks, total kills, attack attempts, and games played.

TEAM CAMP

Dates: July 8-11 Fee: \$345 Per Athlete (8 players minimum)

ELIGIBILITY

Highly popular team camp for all high school levels. The Gonzaga University Team Camp consists of four days of individual skill and team system instruction, competitive drills and tournament play. POSITION SPECIALIZATION CAMP

Dates: July 13-16 Fee: \$345 (Resident), \$275 (Commuter w/meals)

ELIGIBILITY

Designed for girls entering the 8th through 12th grade. Athletes will be grouped by age and ability, including "elite" sections, to ensure the best possible learning experience. Players with developed fundamental skills, including the experienced varsity/club player are encouraged to participate. This camp consists of four days of positional skill instruction, competitive drills, and tournament play. Positions are Outside Hitter, Middle Hitter, Defensive Specialist and Setter. There will be a Late and Early Wave sections with this camp. Fee includes camp photo, t-shirt and volleyball.

COMPLETE PLAYER CAMP

Dates: July 17-19 Fee: \$270 (Resident), \$240 (Commuter w/meals)

ELIGIBILITY

Learn from the Zags! A huge success the past few summers, this camp (formally called the Junior Zag Camp) is an overnight camp designed for girls entering the 6th through 8th grade. Athletes will be grouped by age and experience to ensure the best possible learning experience. Players of all skill levels are encouraged to attend. An emphasis will be made on all-around skills and player development. The Complete Player Camp consists of three days of instruction, team competition and fun. As with all our overnight camps, the residence halls will be highly supervised by camp staff. Fee includes camp photo, t-shirt and volleyball.

ADVANCED SKILLS CAMP

Dates: July 17-19 Fee: \$240 (Resident), \$195 (Commuter w/meals)

ELIGIBILITY

A three day, overnight skills camp for high school players of all skill levels. Get ready for the fall season with all-around skill development, specialized positional instruction and individual and group drills. Team concepts and competition will also be included. Because of the limited number of spaces available with this camp, each athlete will work closely with current Gonzaga athletes and coaches. Fee includes room, meals and camp t-shirt.

Camp is held on the beautiful Gonzaga University campus in Spokane, Washington. All sessions are conducted in the modern, spacious Martin Centre featuring eight indoor courts, modern weight and aerobic training areas, and elevated indoor track. Spokane International Airport is serviced by all major airlines. Airport pickups can be arranged.

ACCOMODATIONS

Overnight campers are housed in Gonzaga University residence halls that are supervised by assigned camp and University security and residence hall staff members. All campers are provided meals in the on-campus student dining commons. Campers must bring their own linen and towels.
